The column dimension is 350mmx 350mm. The area of steel reinforcement is 0.5% of gross concrete area. The grade of steel is Fe 415 and cover to the flanges will be 50mm. CO2- App (16)

- (b) Design a simple supported composite beam with 8m span spaced at 3m c/c. thickness of slab = 100mm. The floor has to carry an imposed load of 2 kN/m<sup>2</sup>, a construction load of 0.75 kN/m<sup>2</sup> and a floor finish load of 0.5 kN/m<sup>2</sup> floor will not be propped during construction.
