- 16 (a) Calculate the dynamic viscosity of an oil, which is used for CO2- App (16) lubrication between a square plate of size 0.8 m x 0.8 m and an inclined plane with angle of inclination 30o as shown in Fig. 1.4. The weight of the square plate is 300 N and it slides down the inclined plane with a uniform velocity of 0.3 m/s. The thickness of oil film is 1.5 mm.

 - (b) Calculate the capillary rise in a glass tube of 2.5 mm diameter CO2- App (16) when immersed vertically in (a) water and (b) mercury. Take surface tensions $\sigma = 0.0725$ N/m for water and $\sigma = 0.52$ N/m for mercury in contact with air. The specific gravity for mercury is given as 13.6 and angle of contact = 130°
- 17 (a) The water is flowing through a pipe having diameter 20cm and CO2- App (16) 10cm at section 1 and 2 respectively. The rate of flow through pipe is 35 liters/sec.
