16. (a) Explain the following inversions of four bar chain mechanism with application: crank lever, double crank and double lever mechanism. CO1-App (16)

- (b) Explain the working of Oscillating cylinder engine, Whitworth quick return motion mechanism and Rotary engine. CO1-App (16)
17. (a) The crank of a slider crank mechanism rotates clockwise at a constant speed of 300 r.p.m. The crank is 150 mm and the connecting rod is 600 mm long. Determine: 1. Linear velocity and acceleration of the midpoint of the connecting rod, and 2. angular CO2-App (16)

velocity and angular acceleration of the connecting rod, at a crank angle of 45° from inner dead centre position.

- (b) PQRS is a four bar chain with link PS fixed. The lengths of the links are $PQ = 62.5$ mm; $QR = 175$ mm; $RS = 112.5$ mm; and $PS = 200$ mm. The crank PQ rotates at 10 rad/sec clockwise. Draw the velocity and acceleration diagram when angle $QPS = 60^\circ$ and Q and R lie on the same side of PS. Find the angular velocity and angular acceleration of links QR and RS. CO2-Ana (16)
18. (a) Draw the profile of a cam operating a knife-edge follower having a lift of 30 mm. the cam raises the follower with SHM for 150° of the rotation followed by a period of dwell for 60° . The follower descends for the next 100° rotation of the cam with uniform velocity, again followed by dwell period. The cam rotates at a uniform velocity of 120 rpm and has a least radius of 20 mm. what will be the maximum velocity and acceleration of the follower during lift and return. CO3-Ana (16)

- (b) Draw the profile of a cam operating a roller reciprocating follower with the following data: minimum radius of cam = 25 mm, lift = 30 mm, roller diameter = 15 mm, the cam lifts the follower for 120° with SHM followed by a dwell period of 30° . Then the follower lowers down during 150° of the cam rotation with uniform acceleration and deceleration followed by a dwell period. If the cam rotates at a uniform speed of 150 rpm, calculate the maximum velocity and acceleration of the follower during the descent period. CO3-Ana (16)
19. (a) A pair of gears, having 40 and 20 teeth respectively, are rotating in mesh, the speed of the smaller being 2000 r.p.m. Determine the velocity of sliding between the gear teeth faces at the point of engagement, at the pitch point, and at the point of disengagement if the smaller gear is the driver. Assume that the gear teeth are 20° involute form, addendum length is 5 mm and the module is 5 mm. Also find the angle through which the pinion turns while any pairs of teeth are in contact. CO4-U (16)

- (b) Two gear wheels mesh externally and are to give a velocity ratio of 3 to 1. The teeth are of involute form; module = 6 mm, addendum = one module, pressure angle = 20° . The pinion rotates at 90 r.p.m. Determine: 1. The number of teeth on the pinion to avoid interference on it and the corresponding number of teeth on the wheel, 2. The length of path and arc of contact, 3. The number of pairs of teeth in contact, and 4. The maximum velocity of sliding. CO4-Ana (16)
20. (a) In an epicyclic gear train, an arm carries two gears A and B having 36 and 45 teeth respectively. If the arm rotates at 150 r.p.m. in the anticlockwise direction about the centre of the gear A which is fixed, determine the speed of gear B. If the gear A instead of being fixed makes 300 r.p.m. in the clockwise direction, what will be the speed of gear B? CO5-U (16)

- (b) In a reverted epicycle gear train, the arm A carries two gears B and C and a compound gear D-E. The gear B meshes with gear E and the gear C meshes with gear B. The number of teeth on gears B, C and D are 75, 30 and 90 respectively. Find the speed and direction of gear C. When gear B is fixed and the arm A makes 100rpm clockwise. CO5-U (16)
